# **PURPOSE**

In our fast-paced world, we often forget to reach out to one another or to non-Christians in meaningful ways. This event is designed to help students develop in the ministry of encouragement in ways that are thoughtful and creative.

## **PROCESS**

#### Each participant will:

- Create the appropriate number of greeting cards from the list for your grade level.
- Make sure that the cards come from the required categories.
- Give to Church Coordinator sent to the Event Coordinator.
- Church Coordinator will collect all Christian Card Design entries and will mail as a bundle to the Event Coordinator on or before **March 1, 2018**.
- Church Coordinator will use a trackable shipping method to send the bundle. LTC-WR recommends USPS Priority Mail, <a href="www.usps.com">www.usps.com</a>.

## The Event Coordinator will:

- Organize the cards for judging.
- Obtain 3 judges who can judge each set of cards.
- Email the results to the Award Entry Coordinator on or before March 15, 2018.

#### **RULES**

- 1. All cards must be handmade. Use of the computer will be limited to printing the words that convey your card's message.
- 2. All cards must have writing on the front of the card followed by an appropriate message on the inside. Use of scripture to accompany your message is encouraged but not required.
- 3. The message MUST be distinctly Christian. It may be on either side of the inside of the card.
- 4. The card must be no smaller than 3 inches by 5 inches when folded. It may be as large as 8 inches by 10 inches when folded.
- 5. The decorations for the card must fit in with the card's message. At least 50% of the card's design must be drawn or painted or stenciled. Feel free to use stickers, stamps, scrapbooking techniques, etc. to complement your design and create depth and texture.
- 6. The cards should be made on white or light-colored card or cover stock paper.
- 7. All 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> graders must submit 3 cards. All 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> graders must submit 4 cards. All 9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> graders must submit 5 cards.
- 8. The cards must fit into the following categories:
